


The first District 13 - International Art Fair...

This event will be held at Drouot, an iconic institution of art history. Located in the heart of the capital, District 13 offers the public a curated selection of some of the most prominent international galleries and representatives of the world of Street Art.



The 13th at its core

A new cultural event in Paris, District 13 finds its inspiration in the city's 13^{th} district, and more specifically the **Tour Paris 13 – the largest ever collective Street Art exhibition** with over 4,500 m² of floor space, walls and ceilings – and **Street Art 13 – a genuine open-air museum** – both projects that are led by Galerie Itinerrance. Opened in 1852 in Paris, Hotel Drouot is the world's largest auction house. Over the years, this institution has forged a place as a focal point for contemporary art. Works from the greatest names throughout the history of art, including Picasso, Matisse, Braque and Dalí, have been sold under the hammer of Drouot's auctioneers.




Hotel Drouot, a first for Street Art



Subliminal Projects

Subliminal, was originally created by Shepard Fairey and Blaize Blouin as an artist collective in 1995. The group played an integral part in introducing skateboarding culture and design to the art world, showcasing artists such as Phil Frost, Thomas Campbell, Mike Mills, Dave Aaron, and Mark Gonzales. Amanda and Shepard Fairey continued to host and curate exhibitions that featured artists such as Ryan McGinness, HunterGatherer, David Ellis, Doze Green, Aesthetic Apparatus, Space Invader, Jim Houser and Andrew Jeffery Wright. In 2003, the SUBLIMINAL PROJECTS gallery was officially opened in the Los Angeles offices of Studio Number One. The scope of the gallery remained true to its roots while embracing new forms of graphic art, illustration, photography and time-based media. Now located in the historic Los Angeles neighborhood of Echo Park, Subliminal Projects continues to offer a platform for artistic exploration and innovation. The perennial schedule includes art exhibitions by established and emerging artists, as well as a lecture series, workshops and artist publications.



Galerie LJ

Founded in Paris in 2017 by Claude Lemarié and Adeline Jeudy, Galerie LJ's programme focuses on emerging artists most of them already internationally acclaimed, with strong figurative inclinations using media as varied as painting, bronze, ceramic, block print, drawing, paper cut-out, wood or fabric.Throughout 10 years of existence, the gallery has had the opportunity to introduce artists little or not yet known in France to the collectors, and support their young international career. Galerie LJ supports for instance Swoon since her early beginnings while Andrew Schoultz is one the most recent artists the gallery has started representing in France.
